Purpose of the EME meeting

The purpose of the meeting was to provide the market with an overview of the upcoming procurement of "IP/MPLS Active Equipment supply, installation and provision of Related Services, Phase 2", to obtain market feedback and concerns on qualification criteria, key risks or potential constraints of the bidding, in order to finalize the bidding document for re-announcing.

Overview of the procurement process

PIU: The Director of PIU welcomed all participants and thanked them for their attendance. It was outlined that the PIU intends to re-announce an open international tender/bidding for procurement of

IP/MPLS active equipment. The bidding was announced on the Georgian electronic Government Procurement (Ge-GP) site ¹, but cancelled.

The Suppliers were asked for participation in EME and were provided the EME questionnaire to find out market capacity, Suppliers' experience on the market and get feedback to decide to amend or not qualification criteria of the tender.

Bank: Bank representatives thanked Suppliers for participation in the meeting and outlined that the purpose of EME meeting is to receive feedback from private sector on what elements can be further improved for the successful outcome in the future bidding and to find opportunities. Suppliers are asked to share their feedback to let PIU amend, revise and improve the Bidding Documents. Hence, Suppliers are encouraging to feel free and send their questions to PIU's email address. The PIU will analyze the feedback and the replies will be shared to this group of discussion.
